

GUIDELINES FOR THE EVALUATION OF HIGH SCHOOL AND TECHNICAL-PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL PROJECTS

There will be changes to the schedules for the evaluation of High School and Technical-Professional School projects compared to 2024. The new schedules have been organized to optimize the process and ensure a more comprehensive participation of evaluators.

The project evaluation will be held in person on October 28, 29, and 30, 2025, in accordance with the established schedule (below) and the guidelines previously defined by the Evaluation Committee.

The involvement of committed and experienced professionals is fundamental to ensuring the quality and excellence of our evaluation process, as well as significantly contributing to scientific and academic development.

EVALUATION SCHEDULE

ATTENTION: projects from all research areas may be evaluated on any of the days and times mentioned in the schedule below.

Wednesday (10/29)	9:00 AM to 12:30 PM	Evaluation only, no public visitation*
Wednesday (10/29)	1:30 PM to 5:00 PM	Concurrently with public visitation
Wednesday (10/29)	6:00 PM to 9:00 PM	Concurrently with public visitation
Thursday (10/30)	1:30 PM to 5:00 PM	Concurrently with public visitation

* Mentors and co-mentors will not be allowed to enter the stand exhibition area during the morning period.

Based on the above, **ALL FINALISTS, FROM ALL RESEARCH AREAS, must attend only on the morning of Wednesday, 10/29/2025**, and remain at their stands from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM. This time slot will be offered to the evaluators so that they have the opportunity to evaluate the projects without the presence of the external public. We emphasize that evaluators are not required to attend on this day and time, which means that some projects may not be evaluated at this moment without the public, without any impact on the final grade.

We also remind you that mentors/co-mentors shouldn't remain near the finalists during the evaluation, so as not to interfere with or compromise the process.
